Annual Schedule:

- Work with Curriculum Outcomes Assessment Task Force (COAT) liaison to prepare assessment plan using university template (template forthcoming) SEPTEMBER
- Develop new or revise previous rubrics
- Submit plan and rubrics to COAT for feedback and approval OCTOBER
- Confirm with major faculty the artifacts that will be used
- Collect evidence NOV-DEC
- Evaluate evidence JAN-MARCH
- Prepare report on findings and provide initial recommendations APRIL-MAY
- Present findings to COAT liaison & seek feedback
- Discuss recommendations, propose final recommendations, & design implementation plan MAY
- Notify COAT of implementation plan & seek feedback & endorsement JUNE
- Implement recommendations JULY-AUGUST
- Present implementation plan to undergraduate faculty at annual national meeting SEPTEMBER
- Update COAT on implementation plan ONE YEAR
